- Architected a multi-sensor retail AI platform integrating RFID, Electronic Shelf Label, computer vision, and Volatile Organic Compound sensors to support inventory prediction, freshness monitoring, and customer engagement analytics.
- Built **D.E.B.O.**, a fully local voice AI agent (faster-whisper · Gemma-4 · Kokoro) with tool calling for camera, shelf label control, and 3D in-store customer guidance.
- Developed **ShelfWatch**, a real-time shelf monitoring system powered by Gemma-4 computer vision; polls Axis camera snapshots at configurable intervals, runs on-device inference via Ollama, and surfaces live anomaly alerts in a Next.js 14 dashboard with Convex and Clerk auth
- Reverse-engineered a proprietary ESL vendor API through network traffic analysis and DevTools inspection, documenting undisclosed endpoints and authentication flows to enable programmatic label control across a retail demo environment
- Designed a statistical anomaly detection system on live RFID sensor streams for ghost stock identification, projecting **\$15K+ in annual savings** via automated variance alerts; built time-series pickup-velocity heatmaps demonstrating **25-45% profit improvement** from data-driven shelf placement

Historical HTR Pipeline (Python · PyTorch · Qwen3-VL · Transformers):

End-to-end handwritten text recognition pipeline for early modern Spanish manuscripts. Fine-tuned [DAN/TrOCR/model] on [dataset]; integrated Qwen3-VL throughout the recognition process — not as post-processing — achieving 90% CER on held-out test set. Pipeline handles layout detection, reading-order recovery, and transcription in a single pass.

DORY (Next.js 15 · TypeScript · PostgreSQL · Tailwind):

Cognitive care companion for dementia and Alzheimer's patients. Culturally adaptive mini-games target distinct brain regions — lyric completion, card matching, autobiographical recall — while an AI companion tracks response quality over time and generates caretaker reports with progress charts and a brain-region activation map.

AskPostgreSQL (Next.js 15 · TypeScript · PostgreSQL · Tailwind · Recharts):

Natural-language analytics platform that converts user questions into SQL queries and generates interactive visualizations from any dataset.
